Switching of loyaltres and changing political parties normally take a place before every general election in the province, which covers half of the country in terms of area.

Winds of change are blowing in Balochistan "Winds of change are blowing in Balochistan", is a commonly held notion in villages and cities of the province these days. Earlier this year, it was the Jamiart ul Ulema e Islam (F) with electables joining the religious party. However, PPP filled the vacuum.
