In yet another announcement, the CM stated that children would inaugurate schools and patients would inaugurate hospitals instead of high level government officials. This is the wealth of the masses not any individual, he added.

CM Bizenjo stated he is school or college, hospital or playground, health card or green bus scheme, all these are people's own money. The Chief Minister said the government has decided not to waste resources on the opening ceremonies to take or give credit on these projects. He said children will inaugurate the school studying in government institutions.

Under treatment patients to inaugurate hospitals

Hospitals will be inaugurated by patients under treatment in government hospitals, he said. Green bus service will be inaugurated by sisters and daughters

who are pushing in public transport, the Chief Minister announced. This is the people's money and the people should be credited. Our job is to use their money properly, he mentioned.

CM directs departments to issue appointment orders within one week

CM Bizenjo also directed all provincial departments to issue appointment orders within one week. In a statement issued by the press secretary to the Chief Minister, the CM has directed the provincial secretaries to issue orders within one week. He mentioned that the departments who completed the test and interview process in April this year should issue orders within one week.

JIT being formed to probe slain lawyer Razzaq Shar killing: DIG Police

QUETTA: Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Police, Ghulam Azfar Maechar on Saturday said a joint investigation team (JIT) was being established to probe into the killing of senior lawyer, Abdul Razzaq Shar Advocate.

Razzaq Shar was a petitioner in an important case seeking registration of treason case against Imran Khan

Addressing a press conference at his office, the DIG said a letter would be written to the provincial government to form a JIT to probe into the killing of slain lawyer, Razzaq Shar Advocate, a senior lawyer of the supreme court of Pakistan was killed on Quetta's Airport Road the other day.



Shar had filed a petition in the Balochistan High Court (BHC) seeking registration of treason case against the former prime minister Imran Khan for dissolving the parliament.
"The killing of senior lawyer being investigated from all aspects", the DIG mentioned. He said the slain lawyer was petitioner in a high profile case, Officials from all law enforcement agencies would be part of the JIT team.

He said there was fear that the stolen weapons would not be used in any terrorism or sabotage. An operation was carried out by attaching an official number plate to a vehicle.

Public urged to stay away from shorelines as Cyclone Biparjoy likely to intensify in next 24 hours

The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) on Sunday urged the public to stay away from shorelines as Cyclone Biparjoy, which is heading towards the coastal areas of Pakistan and India, was likely to intensify in the next 24 hours. "The cyclone is expected to impact southern and south-eastern parts of Sindh on June 13," the agency said in a series of tweets. It warned that cyclones could bring strong winds, torrential rains, and floods in coastal areas. "People should be aware of weather conditions and avoid going to the beach whereas fishermen should avoid boating in the open sea."
The NDMA also called on people to follow local authorities' guidance in any emergency situation.



Over the past few days, the Karachi commissioner has banned entry to the beaches in Karachi, as well as fishing, sailing, swimming, and bathing at seas within the territorial limit of Karachi owing to the threat from today till the end of the storm. Web Desk

Rana Sanaullah says PTI chief to face legal action in two to three weeks

ISLAMABAD: Interior Minister Rana Sanaullah, who cited the May 9 events, said legal action could be initiated against the PTI chairman in two to three weeks.



"While the legal trials of perpetrators and investigators against the law is also tightened around the planners and masterminds who mounted the hate ripened and politically driven rebellion against the state and state institutions to achieve their nefarious design of creating chaos in the country," the ISPR said in a statement.
The military said the unfounded and baseless allegations against the law enforcement agencies and security forces could amount to custodial torture, human rights abuses and stifling of political activities were meant to mislead the people. INP

The violence on May 9 was preplanned and the planning had been made at Zaman Park (the PTI chief's residence in Lahore), the senior PML-N leader told a private TV channel during an interview. Rana Sanaullah said the PTI chief was the architect of hate in politics and the prevailing instability, as he criticised the former ruling party and its policies while explaining the actions being taken against the culprits who tried to trigger anarchy in Pakistan on May 9. Several persons arrested in connection with the attacks on the Lahore corps commander's house and the GHQ in Rawalpindi as well as other acts of arson have already revealed that the entire planning was

finalised at the PTI chief's residence. The statement comes just days after the military's top brass at the 81st Formation Commanders Conference vowed to tighten noose around masterminds and planners of May 9 incidents.

'Transformative day': PM announces arrival of first Russian oil cargo

In a first, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Sunday announced that a vessel carrying Russian oil finally reached Karachi on Sunday and termed it a "transformative day" for the country.
Taking to twitter, PM Shehbaz wrote, "I have fulfilled another of my promises to the nation. Glad to announce that the first Russian discounted crude oil cargo has arrived in Karachi and will begin oil discharge tomorrow."

Pakistan placed its first order for Russian crude oil in April

In April, Pakistan placed its first order for discounted Russian crude oil under a new deal signed between Islamabad and Moscow.
Russian vessel Pure Point — a 183-meter-long oil tanker — carrying 45,000 metric tons of oil docked at birth number 2 at the port.
Expressing his joys on the occasion, the premier said, "We are moving one step at a time toward prosperity, economic growth and energy security and affordability."



He maintained that this was the first ever Russian oil cargo to Pakistan and the beginning of a new relationship between Pakistan and Russia.
"I commend all those who remained part of this national endeavor & contributed to translating the promise of Russian oil import into reality," he added.
Pakistan was initially expecting the vessel from Russia to arrive in Oman on May 27-28.

Delay in arrival of cargo will not increase transportation cost

A Russian cargo vessel carrying 100,000 tonnes of crude oil was behind schedule and reached the Omani port of Duqm on June 7, The News reported on June 6, citing an official.
"The vessel, which was loaded with Ural crude on April 21 at a Russian port, was delayed for 10 days due to technical reasons," the official added.
"It then arrived at Egypt's Suez Canal on May 17, where it waited in a long queue for 12 days to cross the canal." Web Desk

Red alert along coastal areas as 'Cyclone Biparjoy' just 770km away from Karachi

KARACHI: Authorities in Sindh and Balochistan have issued a red alert and banned fishing and swimming along the coastal areas after the very severe Cyclone Storm (VSCS) 'BIPARJOY' over eastern Arabian Sea is maintaining its intensity and hardly 700 kilometers away from Karachi and 760km from Thatta.

The ban was imposed after the Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) issued an alert, advising fishermen not to venture in open sea from Monday, 12 June 2023 onwards till the system is over the Arabian Sea conditions may get very rough/high accompanied with high tides along coast. The tides could rise up to 10 feet as soon as the cyclone strike the coastal belt.

Saturday, the system was located 840km south of Karachi, 830km south of Thatta and 930km south-east of Ormara. The Met department stated that the very severe cyclonic storm -- Biparjoy -- over east-central Arabian Sea was maintaining its intensity and had further tracked north-northeastward during the past 12 hours. It now lies near Latitude 17.3°N & Longitude 67.4°E at a distance of about 840km south of Karachi, 830km south of Thatta and 930km south-east of Ormara. INP.

Cyclone Biparjoy: Karachi commissioner orders removal of billboards

KARACHI: Karachi Commissioner Iqbal Memon has directed authorities concerned to remove all billboards from the city in view of the Arabian Sea Cyclone 'Biparjoy' that has intensified into an 'extremely severe cyclonic storm'.

The cyclonic storm now lies at a distance of about 760km south of Karachi, 750km south of Thatta and 860km southeast of Ormara, according to the weather report. The cyclone's storm's trajectory will likely to remain northwards. Maximum sustained surface winds are 140-160 Km/hour gusts 150 Km/hour around the system center and sea conditions being phenomenal around the system center with maximum wave height 30-40 feet.

Arabic Sea moved north-north-eastwards with a speed of nine km per hour during last six hours. PMD in its late Saturday night advisory warned that the cyclone most likely to track further in north-northeast direction towards southeast Sindh-Indian Gujarat coast.

In a letter written to all deputy commissioners, Memon has directed that all signboards on buildings and rooftops be immediately removed. He also ordered that all deputy commissioners must remain active in their respective areas and do safety measures in view of the rain forecast and gusty winds under the influence of Cyclone Biparjoy.

According to weather reports, Cyclone Biparjoy is likely to make landfall between Karachi and Kutuch district of Indian Gujarat on June 15. The India's Meteorological Department (IMD) said in its forecast.

With its probable north-northeast track, the rain-thunderstorm with some very heavy falls and equally winds (60-80 Km/hour) are expected in southern or southeastern Sindh including Karachi, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Tharparker and Mirpurkhas districts from 13 June evening/night onwards. The high intensity winds may cause damage to lose and vulnerable structures, the Met Office has cautioned. Storm surge of three meters (8-10 feet) can be possible. INP.

3 soldiers martyred, 3 terrorists killed in Miranshah gun battle

MIRANSHAH: Three soldiers embraced martyrdom while three terrorists were also killed during an exchange of fire in the general area of Miranshah, North Waziristan District, the military's media wing said on Sunday.

According to a statement issued by the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), on the night of 09/10 June troops effectively engaged the terrorists' location, and resultantly three terrorists were sent to hell, while four terrorists were injured.

However, during an intense exchange of fire, Subedar Asghar Ali, Sepoy Naseem Khan & Sepoy Muhammad Zaman having fought gallantly, embraced shahada. The ISPR said.

It added sanitization of the area is being carried out to eliminate any other terrorists found in the area. INP.

Bilawal asks PPP office bearers, activists to participate in relief activities in rain hit areas

KARACHI: Foreign Minister Bilawal Bhattu Zardari has expressed deep grief and sorrow over the loss of precious lives and property damages due to rain followed by strong wind, thunderstorm and heavy rain over districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

The foreign minister said that though hundreds of thousands people were rescued during tragic incidents relating monsoon but the affected were still waiting for the pledged financial assistance.

Putting the burden of the climate change on developing country like Pakistan would be injustice, Bilawal Bhattu said urging the global community to support in tackling the devastation caused by the climate change. INP.

11.8m children enrolled through BISP education initiative

ISLAMABAD: The 11.8 million children have been enrolled into schools through Benazir Taleemi Wazafi initiative of the Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP), sources revealed.

According to an official source, a total of 3.0 million children had been enrolled under this scheme during July - March FY2022-23.

Secondary level, Rs. 3,500 and Rs. 4,000 are being paid to the boy and girl students respectively. The girls are also given one-time bonus of Rs. 3,000 on graduation of primary education.

He said that the government's pursuit of its commitment to provide Universal Primary Education as a part of SDGs, she launched a Co-Responsibility Cash Transfer initiative for providing an additional cash per quarter to BISP beneficiary families in October, 2022 for Primary Education. INP.
