less coal miners said. He said after a week the family members were praying for the recovery of the dead bodies of their loved ones. The heirs of the family members of the victims were also present outside the mine when the dead bodies were retrieved. The dead bodies would be handed over to the

heirs of the victims, Syed Saboor Agha, the District Police Officer (DPO) Dukki said. The dead bodies of the hapless coal miners were shifted to the Dukki district headquarters hospital. A large number of fellow coal miners and the heirs of the victims also reached the hospital. Hazardous working

conditions have claimed scores of precious human lives in Dukki and other parts of Balochistan. Rights groups and labourers unions have demanded of the government to improve working conditions for the miners working in coal mines of province.




