QUETTA: In a devastating turn of events, a young doctor lost his life after contracting the deadly Congo virus in Quetta's exvilhospital. This outbreak has affected a total of eight health profes-sionals, comprising five doctors and three nurses.

Dr. Shakarullah Baloch Lost Life

LOST LITE The victim, Dr. Shakarullah Khan Baloch, a dedicated post-graduate doc-tor serving patients, succumbed to the virus while in the line of duty. Meanwhile, two more formale doctors have also fallen prey to this deadly virus. These healthcare heroes, all in seri-ous condition, have been urgently trans-ported to Karachi in an air ambulance for specialized medical treatment.

2 Doctors Critical

The condition of the two infected doctors is reported to be critical. Their exposure to the virus occurred at the Trauma Center of Civil Hospital Quetta. The Medical Superintendent of the Civil Hospital and the Chief of the Trauma Center Pow Remarkhy memory and contents of the

Civil Hospitaland the Chief of the Tatuma Center have Freently requested patients' attendants to refrain from visiting the Trauma Center to prevent further trans-mission of the virus. In response to the crisis, Chief Min-ister Bakchistan, Ali Mardan Domki, has sisued directives to ensure the provision of the best available medical treatment for all infected doctors at the government's expense."
