HOJK heading towards severe power crisis as KPDCL mulling more power cuts

SRINAGAR (INP): Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir is heading towards severe power crisis as the Kashmir Power Distribution Corporation Limited (KPDCL) is multing additional power cuts that monthly power consupption in Kashmir has plummeted by 30 to 40 million units of the compensation of the com

allocation to it.

According to Kashmir Media Service, the current power allocation of 1300 MW is a subanocation of 1500 MW is a sub-stantial decrease from the 1700 MW received during the same period last year, indicating a se-vere shortage that threatens to deepen Kashmir's electricity

woes.

A senior official from KPDCL has raised a red flag over dwindling power allocation, saying. "We are contemplating further extending power cuts as the current allocation is insufficient, especially considering that peak demand during winter can exceed 2000 MW."

The senior official said that

The senior official said that in absence of sufficient power allocation, KPDCL might have no choice but to revise the existing curtailment schedule and
