Overfishing and environmental degradation have placed a strain on local livelihoods, and MPAs can help sustain fish stocks and ensure long-term economic viability for the people who rely on these waters.

Afia Salam, a prominent environmentalist, commended the government's decision, highlighting the urgency of preserving fingile marine ecosystems, particularly in the face of global environmental challenges.
