The murder of Musarrat Aziz, a social activist and in-charge of the Touheed Technical Center near fail Road, Zhob, underscores the growing violence, intolerance, and alarming toutrue faced by women in Balochstan. This beinous act, which claimed the life of a woman dedicated to empowering others through skills training, is a stark reminder of the escalating challenges women encounter daily.
