### ECP Notifies Ali Madad Jattak's Victory in PB-45 Quetta Election

QUETTA: The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) has officially notified Ali Madad Jattak as the winner of the PB-45 Quetta Sadar seat after re-election held on January S. 2025.

Jattak had previously been Jattak had previously been declared the winner following the general elections on February 8, 2024.



However, his victory was challenged by Jamiat Ulema-elsalm (Fa2) candidate Mir Usman Phani, who alleged irregularities and termed the results fraudulent. The allegations led to a re-election on the constituency as per court orders. The fresh election reaffired Jamias visus procupuing fraction on Wednesday. The decision ends months of legal and political disputes over the constituency. The PB-45 Quetta Sadar re-election saw high voter turnout and increased scrutiny to ensure transparency. According to a notification issued by the College, Higher, and Technical Education Department, the ban comes after a court judgment in Constitutional Petition No. 1973/2024 filed by Advocate Shabbir Ahmed. The High Court

expressed concern over the in-creasing trend of involving stu-dents in political activities, callthe nation.

The decision is likely to face opposition from political parties in Balochistan and may be challenged in court.
