Passenger Coach Attacked Near Kalat: 3 Killed, 7 **Injured in Firing Incident**

Abdullah Lehri: A tragic firing incident occurred near Kalat's Niemurgh Cross, where unidentified gummen opened fire on a passenger coach traveling from Karachi to Quetta.

coach traveling from Karachi to Quetta. According to police sources, the attack resulted in the death of at least three pas-sengers, while seven others sus-tained injuries. Law enforce-quickly arrived at the scene, shifting the deceased and injured to the District Headquarters (DHQ) Hospital in Kalat. Police officials confirmed that the coach was directly tar-geted by the assailants. "So far, we have received preliminary information, and rescue opera-tions are still underway," a po-lice spokesperson said. Efforts

The motive behind the at-tack is not yet clear. Security forces have cordoned off the area, and an investigation is un-derway to identify those in-volved.

This strategic timing reflects a broader intention to address rising concentris over accountability, fiscal responsibility, and governance. What's sepecially noteworthy is the reported plan to replace non-elected havmakers. If implemented with sincerity, this could help restore public trust and reduce unnecessary governmet expenditure—expecially as some advis-ers enjoy salaries and allowances equal to fail-fledged ministers without the electorial mandate to back them. Another pressing concern that demands attention is the consistent ab-hence of ministers from their offices.
