

QUETTA: Leaders of six major political parties in Balochistan held a joint press conference at the Queta Press Club, strongly condemning the sucide attack of September 2 at Shahwani Stadium, Saryab Road, during the fourth death anniversary of veteran nationalist leader Sardar Attaullah Mengal.

The tragic attack claimed the lives of 15 political workers and left 41 others injured. Senior leaders, including Mahmood Khan Achakzai of Pashtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PKMAP). BNP leader Sardar Akhtar Jan Mengal, along with representatives of ANP, National Party, PTI, and Majlis Wahdat-ul-Muslimeen, narrowly escaped unharmed.


