## Balochistan Cabinet Approves Minority Endowment Fund, Aviation Strategy, and First-Ever Transgender Policy

### Cabinet Bans Hate Speech, Approves Policies for Transgender and Minority Rights



**Syed Ali Shah:** The Balochistan government has taken major steps to promote inclusivity and social harmony by approving the province's first transgender policy, setting up an endowment fund for minorities, and imposing a province-wide ban on hate speech.

The decisions

were made during the 19th cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Sarfraz Bugti, who called them a guarantee of public interest and sustainable development. He reaffirmed his government's commitment to practical reforms that safeguard the rights of marginalized groups, including women, mi-

norities, and the transgender community, while also promoting equal opportunities and social justice.

Alongside these measures, the cabinet endorsed projects to improve healthcare, education, and infrastructure, including the establishment of a modern hospital in Dalbandin and stricter

rules for medical waste management. The creation of new tehsils and restoration of historic district names were also approved to enhance service delivery. CM Bugti stressed that these decisions reflect transparency, good governance, and a progressive vision for Balochistan's future.

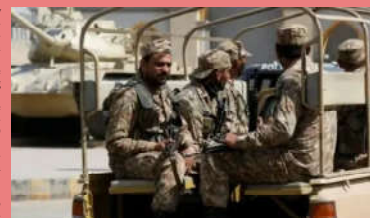
## Four terrorists killed in Balochistan's Mastung operation: ISPR

### Four terrorists killed in Balochistan's Mastung operation: ISPR

**NEWS DESK:** Security forces killed four terrorists on Friday in an intelligence-based operation (IBO) in Balochistan's Mastung area, the military's media wing said in a statement.

According to the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), the IBO was carried out on the reported presence of terrorists belonging to Fitna al Hindustan.

The state uses the term Fitna al Khwarij to refer to terrorists belonging to the banned Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan. It later designated Balochistan-based groups as Fitna al Hindustan to highlight India's alleged role in terrorism and destabilisation across Pakistan. "During the conduct of the operation, own forces effectively engaged the ter-



rorists' location, and after an intense fire exchange, four Indian sponsored terrorists were sent to hell," said the ISPR. The statement added that weapons, ammunition and explosives were also recovered from the dead terrorists, who remained actively involved in terrorist activities in the area. "A sanitisation operation is being conducted to eliminate any other terrorist found in the area, as the security forces of Pakistan are determined to wipe out the menace of Indian sponsored terrorism from the country and reaffirm the nation's unwavering resolve to

bring the perpetrators of terrorism to justice," the ISPR said.

Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi commended the security forces for the successful operation. "Pakistan's security forces thwarted the nefarious designs of Indian-backed terrorists," he wrote on X.

## Pakistan to host next SCO summit: PM Shehbaz

**NEWS DESK:** Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Friday announced that Pakistan will host the next Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit, stating that authorities need to start preparing.

This development comes less than a fortnight after the SCO Summit in Tianjin, China, where Pakistan raised the issue of the Indus Waters Treaty and a joint declaration was issued condemning the attacks on the Jaffar Express, Khuzdar and Pahalgam.

Addressing a ceremony in Islamabad, the PM made the announcement and stated that authorities had to start preparing for the incoming dignitaries.

He did not give a date for the summit.

"We have to start preparing now," the PM said. "We need to build accommodation and beautify Islamabad. Tajikistan gave us saplings as a gift. Chairman CDA (Capital Development Authority) and his team are working day and night to plant them."

Pakistan last hosted the SCO in 2024 for the Council of Heads of Government Summit, where PM Shehbaz called for investing in

the region's collective capacity for connectivity.

A three-day holiday was declared for the summit, which was held amid tight security. Many businesses and routes in the federal capital and its twin city, Rawalpindi, were closed due to safety concerns.

## Balochistan Cabinet Approves Minority Endowment Fund, Aviation Strategy, and First-Ever Transgender Policy

**Qasem Shah:** QUETTA, SEPTEMBER 12: The 19th meeting of the Balochistan Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister Mir Sarfraz Bugti, reviewed progress on previous decisions and approved several landmark initiatives aimed at provincial development, social welfare, and good governance.

Key decisions included the establishment of an Endowment Fund for Minority Welfare, ensuring equal opportunities and improved facilities for minority communities. The cabinet also approved the Provincial Aviation Strategy and a Three-Year Aviation Development Plan (2025-2027) to modernize air travel infrastructure across Balochistan.

Chief Minister Bugti, along with cabinet members, praised the Aviation Directorate for successfully conducting an emergency air rescue mission from Turbat to Karachi, which saved three lives.

The cabinet further approved granting tehsil status to Sakran and Karbala, aiming to provide local populations with easier access to



essential services.

For the first time in Balochistan's history, the cabinet approved a comprehensive Transgender Policy to protect community rights and promote their social and economic inclusion.

### Other major approvals included:

Endorsement of federal legislative bills on amendments to the Law

of Evidence and the Constitution (2024).

Ban on the publication of hate material to promote harmony and tolerance.

Integration of technical education institutes under BTEVTA for better vocational training.

Establishment of a modern Prince Fahd Hospital in Dalbandin to enhance healthcare facilities.

Restoration of historical district names Khaliqabad and Shaheed Sikandarabad as per the Supreme Court's directive.

Approval of Hospital Waste Management Rules 2025 for safe and efficient disposal of medical waste.

Exemption of World Food Programme consignments to Afghanistan from development charges, as part of Pakistan's humanitarian support role.

The cabinet also reviewed initiatives to rehabilitate drug addicts, appreciated the Social Welfare Department's efforts, and formed a committee to monitor progress. In addition, detailed discussions were held on matters of livestock, forestry, IT, mines, minerals, education, local government, law, and infrastructure development.

Speaking at the meeting, CM Bugti emphasized that the cabinet's decisions represent transparency, good governance, and the government's commitment to inclusive development. He stressed that projects in health, education, and infrastructure are being launched to ensure long-term prosperity for the people of Balochistan.

## Pakistan's future rests with its youth: Rana Mashhood

LAHORE (INP): Chairman of Prime Minister's Youth Programme Rana Mashhood Ahmad Khan has said that Pakistan's future rests with its youth, stressing that today's students are tomorrow's leaders and must be transformed from job-seekers into job-creators.

He expressed these views on Friday while addressing a ceremony at the University of Education, Lahore, organized in connection with the Prime Minister's Youth Initiatives and the Digital Youth Hub.

Rana Mashhood said that equipping young people with modern skills and technology is the government's foremost priority. He noted that over one million laptops have already been distributed, while National Incubation Centers fund more than 150 innovative projects each year. Through the Digital Youth Hub, he added, scholarships on merit, online courses, world-class certifications, internships, freelancing opportunities, and startup investment facilities are being provided to enable youth to become self-reliant and contribute to strengthening the economy. The chairman announced that within the next two to three months, Pakistan's first Adolescent Youth

Policy would be introduced, aimed at granting youth access to modern opportunities and ensuring their active participation in national development.

Highlighting the government's commitment to higher education, he said that both local and international scholarships are being offered so that no student is deprived of education due to lack of resources. He also urged female students to register on the Digital Youth Hub platform to avail themselves of government facilities.

Rana Mashhood further emphasized that Pakistan's foundations were built on the blood of martyrs, calling upon the youth to remain vigilant against enemy conspiracies and play their role in the nation's defense. "The recent Pakistan-India war is proof that our nation always stands as a solid wall in difficult times," he remarked. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, he said, revolutionary measures are being taken to empower the younger generation, with the Digital Youth Hub serving as a practical manifestation of these steps. He urged students to register and actively contribute to the country's progress.

## IHC CJ Dogar clarifies remarks about Imaan Mazari

ISLAMABAD (INP): Islamabad High Court (IHC) Chief Justice (CJ) Sardar Sarfaraz Dogar has clarified his earlier remarks about lawyer and human rights activist Imaan Mazari, stating that his words were taken out of context and distorted.

During the hearing of another case on Friday, Justice Dogar said his comments in a previous case (about Dr Mahrang Baloch and her name on the ECL) were misrepresented, creating unnecessary controversy. "Imaan Mazari is like my daughter," he explained. "As Chief Justice and as an elder, I was only trying to guide her, but my remarks were twisted into something they were not." The Chief Justice noted that he had only advised Imaan Mazari that while she can disagree with judicial decisions, personal attacks should not be made.

"Since yesterday, it has been spread that I said I would have her arrested. In reality, I had addressed Hadi Sahib, warning that if she was not stopped, I would proceed with contempt of court," Justice Dogar clarified. He further emphasised that his in-

tention was just to prevent any harm to Imaan Mazari.

"I told her she is free to disagree with my judgements, but she should have had to avoid an attack on me personally. I never said I would 'arrest' her. The phrase has been misrepresented," he added. Justice Dogar recalled that he had asked Hadi Sahib to take her aside; otherwise, he would be compelled to bring contempt of court proceedings.

"If that happened, it would damage her career," he said. "I spoke to her as one would to their own child. But she kept insisting on fundamental rights. Does this court not also have fundamental rights?"

It is pertinent to mention here that yesterday On Thursday, an exchange of hot words was witnessed between Islamabad High Court (IHC) Chief Justice (CJ) Justice Sarfaraz Dogar and Advocate Imaan Mazari, counsel for Dr Mahrang Baloch, a Baloch nationalist and detained leader of the Baloch Yakkhi Council (BYC), during the hearing of the case of excluding the latter's name from the Exit Control List (ECL).

## Senate committee approves legislative bills related to diyat, women rights and public welfare

ISLAMABAD (INP): The Senate Standing Committee on Law and Justice on Friday approved various legislative bills related to diyat, women rights and public welfare.

The Committee, under the leadership of Chairman Senator Farooq Hamid Naek, convened at Parliament House in continuation of its earlier session to consider pivotal reforms in criminal law, family law, and constitutional provisions. Demonstrating a strong commitment to public welfare and legislative responsiveness, the Committee unanimously passed significant public-centered reforms aimed at strengthening access to

justice and promoting legal equity. The Committee approved crucial amendments to the Pakistan Penal Code (Amendment) Bill, 2025, tabled by Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri, raising the minimum value of diyat from 30,663 grams to 45,000 grams of silver. The revised figure reflects changing economic realities and aims to standardize the financial component of compensation in light of inflation and public expectations. Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri assured that the amendment strictly adheres to Islamic injunctions, reinforcing the Bill's alignment with Shariah principles.

ISLAMABAD (INP): Federal Minister for Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony, Sardar Muhammad Yousof on Friday met with Iran's Ambassador to Pakistan, Dr. Reza Amiri Moghadam, to discuss bilateral cooperation on religious affairs, promotion of interfaith harmony, and facilitation of pilgrims.

During the meeting, the Iranian envoy expressed deep sorrow over the loss of lives and property caused by recent rains and floods in Pakistan, assuring that Iran stood shoulder to shoulder with its brotherly neighbor in this time of trial.

The two sides held wide-ranging discussions on tackling global challenges, including religious intolerance, terrorism, sectarianism, and the need to strengthen interfaith dialogue.

Sardar Yousof said Pakistan was taking steps to regularize the travel of pilgrims to Iran and Iraq. He announced that a memorandum of understanding (MoU) concerning Pakistani pilgrims and workers traveling to Iran would soon be signed, with the assistance of the Ministries of Religious Affairs, Interior, and Overseas Pakistanis.

## Pakistan urges UNSC to hold Israel accountable for "illegal, unprovoked aggression" against Qatar

NEW YORK (INP): Pakistan has called on the UN Security Council to go beyond mere condemnation of the Israeli strikes targeting Hamas negotiators and hold Israel accountable for its "illegal and unprovoked aggression" against Qatar.

Speaking in the 15-member Council's emergency meeting on the Middle East, Ambassador Asim Fikri Ahmad, permanent representative of Pakistan to the UN, also underscored the need for safeguarding the role and protection of mediators engaged in peace efforts, and recommit to the centrality of international law and the UN Charter in maintaining international peace and security.

The meeting was requested by Pakistan, Algeria and Somalia that took place under South Korea, the Council President for the month of September.

"Pakistan condemns, in the strongest possible terms, the illegal and unprovoked Israeli aggression against the brotherly State of Qatar," the Pakistani envoy said, calling it a "reckless and provocative attack" on the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Qatar.

Pointing out that the Israeli strikes targeted a residential neighborhood, deliberately endangering civil

"In a gesture of solidarity and regional unity, Prime Minister of Pakistan H.E. Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, accompanied by a high-level delegation, including the Deputy Prime Minister/Foreign Minister is visiting Qatar today," Ambassador Asim Fikri Ahmad told delegates.

## Supreme Court takes up review appeal of Noor Mukadam's killer

ISLAMABAD (INP): A three-member bench of the Supreme Court (SC) on Friday adjourned the hearing of the review appeal of Zahir Zakir Jaffer against the apex court's verdict that upheld his death sentence for the gruesome murder of Noor Mukadam in Islamabad in 2021.

Noor Mukadam, aged 27 years, was found murdered at Zahir's Islamabad residence in July 2021, with the probe revealing she was brutally tortured by him before being beheaded. Zahir Jaffer's death sentence by the trial court had already been upheld by the Islamabad High Court (IHC).

During hearing of the review appeal on Friday, Advocate Khawaja Haris appeared in court on behalf of Zahir Jaffer, instead of Barrister said that Salman Safdar, who had represented the convict earlier. Seeing this, Justice Hashim Kakar enquired: "Barrister Salman Safdar represented Zahir Jaffer before. Whether a lawyer can be changed during the hearing of a review petition?"

Barrister Haris informed the court that a lawyer can be changed as per the new law. Justice Hashim Kakar went on to ask: "Was the law changed for someone or in principle?"

Justice Hashim Kakar remarked that he himself had written the verdict in this case and an additional note from Justice Ali Baqir Naif was still awaited. He said that maybe you would get some benefit from the additional note.

"In the process of hurry, mistakes were made in the investigation and during trial," the petition quoted a verdict from another case.

On the rape charges, the review plea argued that it was "apparent from the record that there is no evidence on the record in proof of this allegation".

The SC had commuted Zahir's death sentence on the rape charge to life imprisonment, as decided by the trial court, but did not acquit him.

## Rising Indus waters threaten villages across Sindh

HYDERABAD (INP): The flow of water in the Indus River at Guddu Barrage has surged to 512,665 cusecs, causing a medium-level flood that has inundated several villages along the Sindh-Punjab border. Floodwaters have cut off many areas. According to the Control Room, water levels at Guddu Barrage will continue to rise over the next 24 hours. Currently, inflow at 512,665 cusecs, while outflow stands at 480,455 cusecs. The rising waters have submerged sugarcane, cotton, rice, and vegetable fields in riverine tracts, while severe erosion has been reported in Kashmir, putting immense pressure on protective embankments. In Uch Sharif, floodwaters from the Sutlej and Chenab rivers have submerged dozens of villages, including Mauza Gumani. Entire communities such as Basti Mastoi, Basti Kalha, Basti Gumani, and Basti Phuleli have been devastated. Victims say many people remain trapped in the flood-hit areas, while others are stranded under the open sky without any govern-

ment assistance. On the bank of the Chenab River, floodwaters have swallowed homes and crops in Sahmal village of Bhawana, Chiniot. Victims complain that no tents or shelters have been provided by the administration, forcing families to spend cold nights under the open sky with their children.

The Ravi River continues to wreak havoc with a low-level flood at Shakarghar, where erosion threatens the Dera Noor Malik embankment. Locals have demanded urgent protective measures. In Kabirwala, floodwaters have submerged the new building of Haveli Koranga Police Station. With five to six feet of water inside, records are at risk of being destroyed, and prisoners have been shifted to the Sutlej Police Station. In the Rahim Yar Khan district, floodwaters have wreaked havoc in Khampur's Chashran Sharif area. As a precaution, the Multan Electric Power Company (MEPCO) has cut power supply to 72 villages. MEPCO's Executive Engineer Iqbal Bhutto stated that power will be restored once floodwaters recede.
